


Sage WageEasy CHILD SUPPORT

Factsheet: Setting Up a Child Support Deduction Allowance


This fact sheet is designed to offer assistance with the setup of child support deductions in Sage WageEasy.

Child support deductions are setup in Sage WageEasy as allowance deductions, untaxed and not included in super calculation. The below screen shot is an example. Depending on the amount to be deducted, the allowance can be setup with a predetermined amount each pay, as a percentage, or left as zero if the amount needs to be calculated each time.



As an allowance deduction, payment can be directed automatically to a 3rd party bank account. This is done from the Bank tab within the allowance, after the allowance has been setup. Bank details would be provided from the relevant government agency.





There is a user defined report on Child Support payments that can be run to provide you with details of all child support payments. There is also a standard report under Banking | Allowance payments providing details on all allowance payments that have been included in the banking (ABA) file.
