

Sage WageEasy Rental Licence Procedure

Sage WageEasy- Rental Licence Procedure

During peak periods you may require a temporary increase to your active licences within Sage WageEasy. Rather than purchasing additional active licences there is an option to rent additional licences for a specified period.

Process:

You will need to print a new registration form increasing the number of employees to incorporate the number of rentals you wish to buy. **IMPORTANT:** Rental licence increases must be for a minimum of 10 licences.

Then email or fax it to support but must include the following details:

- 1. How Many active employee licences you wish to rent
- 2. Start date and End Date of rental period (Must be the Pay Period End dates)
- 3. What their pay cycle is eg: Weekly, Fortnightly or Monthly

Pricing: Current as at 1st April 2014, please confirm with licensing.wageeasy.au@sage.com

Weekly Pays:

- 1 2 weeks, the rental fee \$3.00 + GST per pay per employee
- 3 4 weeks, rental fee \$2.00 + GST per pay per employee
- 5 unlimited number of weeks, rental fee \$1.50 + GST per pay per employee

This would mean if the numbers grew for a function by 100 employees, the rental for 2 weeks would be only \$600.00 + GST compared with an outright purchase on the software of \$7000.00 + GST + 20% support.

Fortnightly Pays:

- 1- 2 pays \$5.00 + GST per pay per employee
- 3 4 pays \$3.50 + GST per pay per employee
- 5+ (to unlimited) \$2.50 + GST per pay per employee

Monthly / 4 weekly Pays:

1 pay - \$6.50 + GST per pay per employee

2-4 pays \$5.00 + GST per pay per employee

5+ (to unlimited) \$4.00 per pay per employee
