## Electronic Waste (eWaste) Program

Oracle's eWaste Program offers you a convenient and economical option for disposing of retired and decommissioned hardware. The program is available to all Oracle customers on all hardware products – regardless of brand or manufacturer - as part of a Sun/Oracle return. Simply de-install, pack and stage the old hardware for pick up and Oracle will collect, transport and recycle the equipment at no charge. For select systems, Oracle may provide free de-installation services.

## Upgrade Advantage Program

As your business needs grow, Oracle's industry-leading systems can help you meet your objectives. Whether you are upgrading your Oracle hardware to boost performance, reduce Total Cost of Ownership (TCO), meet regulatory mandates, or expand your capacity, you may be eligible for the Upgrade Advantage Program. This program saves you money with trade-in discounts on new Oracle systems when returning qualified used equipment. There is no charge for pick up, transport or recycling of the retired hardware, and de-installation services are available at no cost on select systems.

## System Return Credit

Your unwanted hardware may qualify for Oracle's Systems Return Credit program. This program pays for select decommissioned hardware and the dollar value is then applied as a credit towards current obligations with Oracle. There is no charge for pick up, transport or recycling of the decommissioned hardware and de-installation\* services are available at no cost on select systems. A certified transfer of ownership is also provided. Minimum amounts apply and this program may not be combined with any other programs or discounts.

## Additional Onsite Services Available

Select Sun/Oracle hardware products may be eligible for additional onsite services free of charge. These service are also available for a fee for other hardware systems:

- **Onsite Data Erasure (disk wipe):** Oracle will perform a one-pass “wipe” of any disks (HD/SSD) and generate an erasure report. For devices where erasure is not complete, the customer can choose to keep the device or have Oracle destroy the device. To perform this service, the system(s) containing the disk(s) must be connected to power and operational.
- **De-installation Service:** Oracle personnel will de-install and package the retired system(s). The customer is responsible for the staging and relocation of all hardware.
- **Certification of Ownership Transfer:** Transfer of ownership is complete when decommissioned systems are loaded on to the certified Oracle carrier's truck. Oracle will then assume responsibility for the hardware.

## Hardware Harvesting & Recycling

Oracle is committed to developing practices and products that help protect the environment. We evaluate all systems for spares harvesting opportunities, then test and/or repair components before placing them into our supply chain. Corrupted disks are destroyed upon receipt, and all non-harvested materials are recycled according to local environmental regulations.

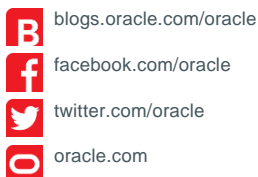
