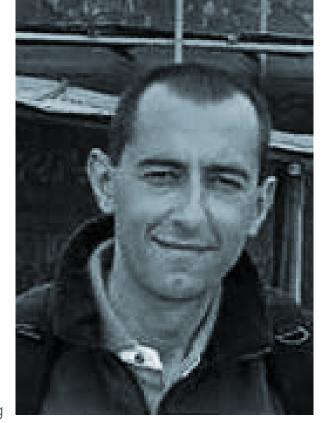

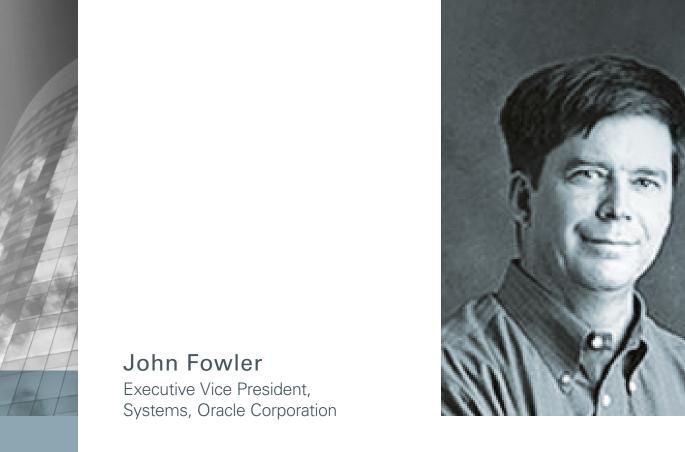




Cahit Erdoğan CIO, Yapi Kredi Bank

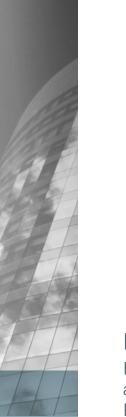

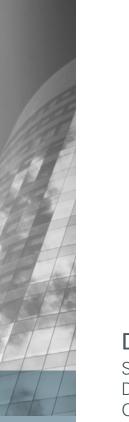


Duncan Stott CIO, Kier
