

Adobe Document Cloud eSign services: November 2015 Release Notes

Adobe introduces breakthrough user and workflow experiences, advanced e-sign options and powerful new capabilities for enterprise excellence.

Overview

This document provides highlights about the new features and changes that are included in the November release.

Expanded Workflow Automation and Control for Admins

- Workflow Designer—Create custom workflow templates for senders so process steps can be followed consistently
 every time.
- **Digital signatures**—Enable workflows that meet advanced signing requirements in the EU and in regulated industries with certificate-based signatures. This feature will be generally available with the November release.
- **User permissions delegation**—Increase team productivity by creating virtual accounts that can be shared by multiple people—and letting admins or users delegate send, modify, and view privileges to an alternate user.
- New APIs—Expand e-sign options in your enterprise apps with new APIs for initiating custom workflows, form field placement and authoring, and add recipient group.

Powerful new capabilities for Senders

- New send agreement experience—Give senders more control over the signing process with a new, easy-to-use Send experience.
- **Hybrid routing order**—Get documents signed or approved in exactly the right order—let senders specify sequential or parallel routing—or use a mixture of the two.
- **Delegator role**—Easily route documents when the signer's email is not known or an intermediary is needed—require participant to delegate signing to another person.
- On-the-fly document correction—Save time when the wrong document gets accidentally sent—let senders fix a signing request without cancelling and starting over.

Enhanced Mobile Security & Productivity

- **Camera capture**—Let users use their iOS device camera to take a photo of their handwritten signature, then use it to sign a document.
- **Signature sync**—Give users access to their signature image across web and mobile experiences with automatic synchronization.
- Search or filter agreements—Be more productive on your mobile device with access to more stored agreements and the ability to quickly search and find the right agreement.
- Enterprise Mobile Management (EMM)—Securely manage Adobe eSign Manager DC mobile app on employee's
 devices using Android for Work. Integration with Good Technology coming soon.
- New send UI for Android

 —eSign Manager DC for Android has a new, more intuitive send experience plus support for
 KBA and phone authentication.
